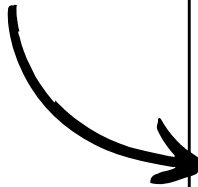
CONSTRUCT AN LD CASE!

Resolved: Violent revolution is a just response to political oppression.

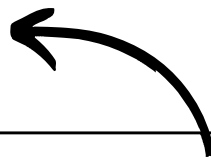

Write an AFF or NEG case!



- a study that found violent uprisings lead to mass killings
- a framework about reducing structural violence
- people have a right to self-defense
- a framework about maximizing good consequences
- oppressed groups don't have the same ability to change the system because they often lack influence
- framework about the social contract and obligations of a government
- a piece of evidence explaining why non-violence no longer works
- a study that found revolutions lead to more dictatorships
- long-term violence decreases in countries after political revolutions
- peaceful revolutions are more successful
